We advise on acquisitions and disposals of freehold and leasehold interests, commercial leasing including agreements for lease, and sale and leaseback arrangements.

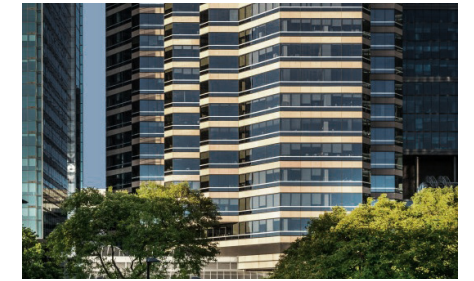
We also advise on the property aspects of corporate transactions, including title due diligence, easements and tenure matters.
